

Health Policy

The health policy of Miami Springs Baptist Preschool, as mandated by The Department of Children & Families is as follows:

Ill children be excluded from school to prevent communicable diseases from spreading. Any child that is ill should not return to school until symptoms of the illness are no longer present, or with medical authorization from a doctor.

A child should not come to school if he/she exhibits any of the following signs/symptoms of suspected communicable diseases:

- Severe coughing, causing the child to become red or blue in the face, or if the cough has a whooping sound to it
- Difficult or rapid breathing
- A stiff neck
- Diarrhea (more than 1 abnormally loose stool within a 24-hour period)
- A temperature of 101 degrees Fahrenheit or higher
- Conjunctivitis (Pink Eye)
- Exposed, open skin lesions (Impetigo)
- Head Lice
- Any other unusual signs or symptoms of illness

If a child exhibits any of these symptoms while at the preschool, a parent or other authorized individual, as indicated on the emergency contact list, will be required to pick up the child within 1 hour.

The above policy enables Miami Springs Baptist Preschool to provide a safe, healthy environment, and reduce the risk of communicable diseases from spreading.
